About MCCSN and our Walk-A-Thon

Multi-County Cancer Support Network (MCCSN) is a non-profit organization approved as a 501(c)(3) organization in 1993. It is designed to provide emotional, educational and financial support to cancer patients and their families who reside in Bedford, Coffee, Franklin, Gundy, Lincoln, Marion, Moore and Warren counties. MCCSN provides educational support by offering a library of books, brochures and other resource materials. Emotional support is offered through quarterly support meetings as well as one on one support as requested. Financial support is provided in the form of essential living expenses such as utilities, food vouchers or travel reimbursement for cancer treatments. Wheelchairs, walkers, wigs and mastectomy prostheses and bras are also available in the office at no charge for cancer patients.

The founding members decided a Walk-A-Thon would be a good way to raise much needed funds. The annual Walk-A-Thon is held each year on the second Friday of September and will be held again this year at the Old Franklin County High School Stadium located at 801 Dinah Shore Boulevard in Winchester.







The Walk-A-Thon begins at 6:00 p.m. with a ceremonial first lap walked by cancer survivors in honor of their victory against cancer. Formed teams then continue to walk throughout the evening. At 9:00 p.m. we begin an emotional Candlelight Ceremony to honor cancer survivors, as well as remember those that have lost their lives to cancer since the last Walk-A-Thon. The quilt drawing and team plaques are awarded at 10:00 p.m. as teams continue to walk until the closing ceremony at 11:30 p.m.
