Cookbooks still available

There is still a supply of cookbooks, Favorite Recipes from MCCSN Supporters, available. Do keep them in mind for gifts as the Christmas season approaches. Copies are available at the MCCSN office and at the Winchester Antique Mall.

As a little enticement, following is just one of the many delicious recipes submitted – this one by MCCSN President Cile Alexander.

Swedish Oatmeal Cookies

3/4 c. flour

1/2 c. sugar

1/2 c. brown sugar

1/2 tsp. salt

1/2 tsp. soda

1/2 c. margarine

1/2 tsp. vanilla

1 egg

1-1/2 c. rolled oats

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Combine all ingredients except oats. Beat 1 minute at medium speed. Stir in oats and set aside while making topping (below). Drop the dough by rounded teaspoons 2 inches apart on an ungreased cookie sheet. Bake 8 minutes and then spoon ½ teaspoon of the topping onto the center of each cookie. Bake an additional 6 to 8 minutes more or until browned. 2 cookies = 211 calories

Topping

1/3 c. sugar 1/4 c. margarine 1 T. corn syrup 1/3 c. chopped almonds 1/8 tsp. almond extract

In a small saucepan combine sugar, margarine and corn syrup; bring to a boil. Remove from heat and stir in almonds and almond extract. Set aside.


