Look at what you have done!

So far in 2016:

Individuals/families helped while undergoing cancer treatment:
69 + 56 + 71 + 44 = 240

Amount expended in helping meet the needs: \$33,001.21 + 32,992.41 + 32,805.77 + 15,897.05 = \$114,696.44

The amounts and totals above are for three full quarters of the year and through November 14 of this fourth quarter - so still one and a half months remaining. Quite an accomplishment!

This has all been made possible by those of you out there - the caring, untiring supporters of MCCSN. Whether donations, memorials, honorariums, various fundraising projects by many organizations and individuals, all the various types of fundraising and support at the Walk-A-Thon ... year after year ... you make it happen.

The Walk-A-Thon produced \$60,366.81, which means almost double that amount is needed to meet the needs of MCCSN's cancer beneficiaries this year! So look carefully at what you have done and continue to do!

Everyone having experience with cancer knows how expensive financially and demanding emotionally it is on the person and family. What a blessing to them and to this support network, as everyone at MCCSN continues to see how supportive and caring the people in this eight county area are toward those facing hardship.
