**Have you met Jimmy?**

Jimmy Mullins came on board as a director of MCCSN January of this year. Jimmy was born in Kentucky and graduated from Virginia Tech with a degree in mechanical engineering. Shortly thereafter he entered the Air Force where he spent 28 years, retiring in 1979 at Arnold AFB as a Lt. Col. While in the Air Force he earned an advanced degree in astronautics from AFIT. The majority of his career was spent in the Air Force Systems Command where he was involved with the Atlas, Titan and Minuteman missile systems.

Jimmy and his wife, whom sadly he lost in 2015, were married in France in 1956 and had three children. Two of whom survive: their daughter who graduated from Northwestern University and lives in Waterloo, IL and is retired and their son who graduated from Tennessee Tech, lives in Tullahoma and works for Bridgestone Tire Company. Jimmy also lives in Tullahoma and has been active in the Tullahoma Kiwanis Club and with Meals-on-Wheels.
