Multi-County Cancer Support Network's New Home
501 West Broad Street
Decherd Tennessee

In February 2017, the Board of Directors received notice that our landlord, Hospice of the Highland Rim Foundation (HHRF) would be selling the building where we are currently located on East Lauderdale Street, Tullahoma. Our current lease expires in October 2017, so we needed to find a new facility quickly. The Board immediately designated a Facilities Search Committee, chaired by Kenny Delaney, to identify, evaluate and recommend a suitable location which would serve our clients and their families and our staff. We also wanted to have an appealing and visible location to the communities we serve to facilitate participation of friends and supporters of MCCSN who have so unselfishly contributed time, effort and resources for almost 25 years. Over 30 potential locations were evaluated.

In Oct 2017, an office/meeting facility was selected by the Board to be our new home. The new location is in the educational building of the Decherd Presbyterian Church at 501 W. Broad Street, Decherd, TN (map on page 2). There will be an efficient and comfortable setting for our clients, supporters and staff to use. There is plenty of parking space to accommodate those who attend our Quarterly Support Meetings; and we will be able to move in prior to our lease expiration with minimal disruption of services to our clients. 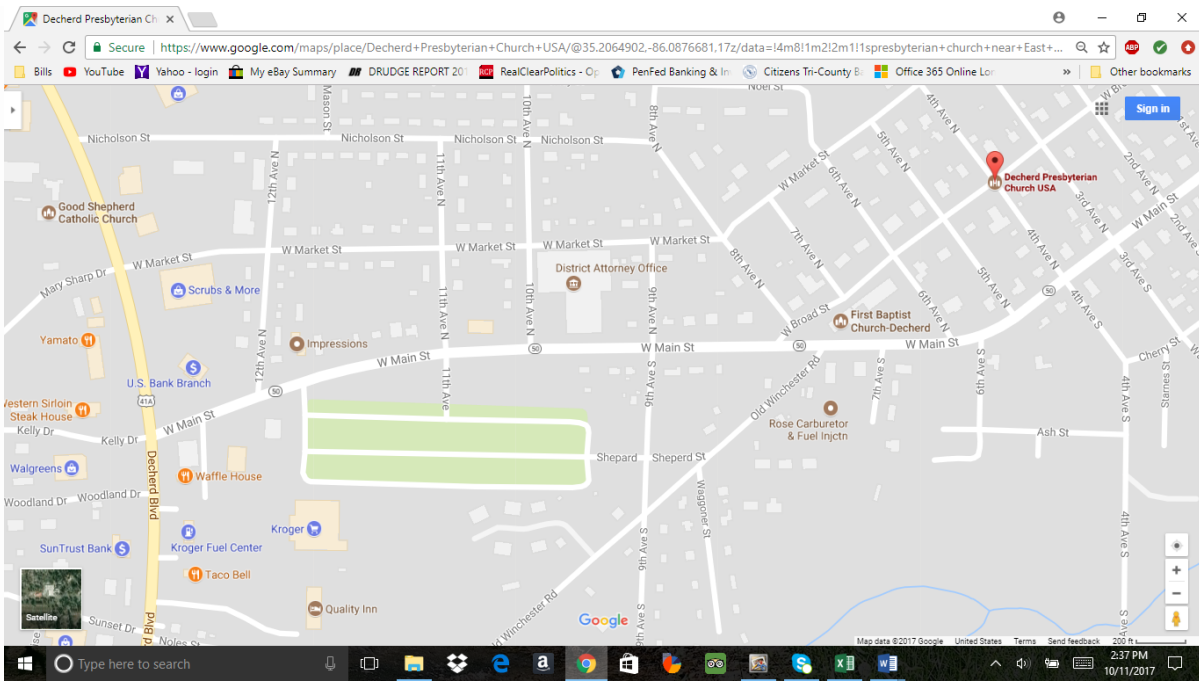
