**Fabulous Fifties Cast and Crew Receives
Tennessee Public Health Association Award**

During the Tennessee Public Health Association annual conference held September 14-16 at the Franklin Marriot Cool Springs Hotel in Franklin, Tennessee, the *Fabulous Fifties Cast and Crew* was awarded the 2016 Tennessee Public Health's Partners and Leadership Award. The PAL Award is presented to a non-public health professional, group, or organization which has made a significant contribution on behalf of public health that is extraordinary and would set an example for others. The award was presented by Tennessee Department of Health Commissioner John J. Dreyzehner, MD, MPH and Tennessee Public Health Association President Ami Mitchell.

The *Fabulous Fifties Cast and Crew* of eighty volunteers was recognized for the numerous hours donated annually to raise funds for the Multi-County Cancer Support Network. These funds provide essential living expenses like utilities, food and gas for cancer patients. Additionally, the Cast and Crew was recognized for multiple events they participate in to raise funds for patients with other health concerns. Acknowledgement was also given for their partnership with the Lincoln County Health Department to promote reduction of second hand tobacco exposure in the community.
