Friends and family members of the late Kate Bratcher gather together each year to participate in the annual 5k walk/run to honor her memory. This event has inspired hundreds to join the 5k fun and run or walk to honor or remember a loved one of their own.

The Kate Walk is a FREE event held in Downtown Tullahoma near the Kiwanis Club's 41A festival. The run/walk will begin near 102 N E Atlantic Street in Tullahoma at 9:00 a.m., with important announcements beginning at 8:45. Parking is available at First Baptist Church.
